All pools are available for general swim and private rentals during the summer. Fees are for 2 hours of pool time. Parties must be paid in full 10 days after booking the party. All parties must be booked a minimum of 14 days in advance. General Swim Parties may stay late or arrive early during General Swim but may only use the tables during the two-hour time period they have reserved. Groups are allowed to bring in decorations, food and drink (no alcohol, glass containers, tobacco, balloons or confetti). Lifeguards are included. **Please call the pool of your choice for availability and reservations.**

Certification Classes

Lifeguarding/First Aid and CPR/AED for Lifeguards. Candidates must attend all classes and be 15 years of age. Must be 16 to work for the City of Corpus Christi.

Session III: July 7, 9-10, 14, 16-17 & 21 at Parker Pool

A Word to Parents

The Corpus Christi Parks & Recreation staff strives to maintain the highest standards in emergency training. Our goal is to provide patrons with a safe and clean atmosphere in which families can enjoy themselves in a recreation environment. The purpose of the staff is not to supervise your child, but to prevent accidents from happening. Therefore, parents are to closely supervise their children and assist in enforcing the facility's policies for the safety and enjoyment of all patrons. The City of Corpus Christi is not responsible for injuries or accidents. All children ages eight years and younger must be accompanied and supervised at all times by a paying adult (age 16 years or older).

Pool Rules

1. All children ages eight years and younger must be accompanied and supervised at all times by a paying adult (age 16 years or older).
2. Only US Coast Guard approved flotation devices are permitted. Anyone wearing a flotation device must be directly supervised (within arm's reach). No flotation devices may be worn on slides or diving boards.
3. Swimsuits, swim-diapers or swim trunks only - no shorts, t-shirts, diapers, thongs, etc.
4. Swim diapers are required for all those who are diaper dependent.
5. Food and drink may be brought into facilities (no glass or alcohol). Management reserves the right to check bags and coolers. Food and drink may only be consumed in designated areas.
6. Shower before entering any pool to prevent Recreational Water Illnesses (RWIs). Visit www.cdc.gov/healthyswimming.

Swim Lessons

The City of Corpus Christi provides American Red Cross Learn to Swim Program. Lessons are offered for ages 6 months to adult. Classes are offered Tuesday through Friday for two consecutive weeks. Morning and evening sessions are available at Collier, Greenwood, Natatorium, Oso, Parker, and West Guth. Minimum 2/Maximum 6 per class. On Tuesday, May 25, open registration for all pools will be held at the Natatorium from 4–7pm, for the first Summer Session dates of June 8–18. Private lessons are available afternoons at the Natatorium from 12pm–1pm. All classes are 30 minutes long. Missed classes cannot be made up.
