Entry numbers, which will determine parade order, will be distributed at that meeting. Entry forms will not be accepted after the mandatory skipper’s meeting. The parade is scheduled to begin at approximately 6:30 p.m. on Saturday, December 5, 2008. All boats, whether home-ported or visiting in the Corpus Christi Municipal Marina, will be judged for prizes awarded in three categories: Power Boat, Sail Boat and Commercial Vessel. All entries will be judged considering the “**SANTA’S WORKSHOP HOLIDAY**” theme, lighting, decorations and crew participation. The Overall Harbor Lights Champion will be added to the Harbor Lights Perpetual Trophy which is displayed at a local business year-round.

SAFETY TIPS for Lighting of the Harbor: (1) Use grounded cords. (2) Don’t let any electric cords touch the mast or shrouds. (3) Try to cover all electrical connections. (4) Do not use worn or frayed electrical cords. (5) Do not use electric cords during rainy weather. (6) Use support lines so electric cords and light strings are not weight supported.
